### Angel Hair Pasta with Vegetables

- |  |                     |
|--|---------------------|
| 2 T Olive Oil                                  | 1 tsp Dried Basil   |
| 1 C Squash, diced                              | 1 tsp Dried Oregano |
| 1 C Zucchini, diced                            | ½ tsp Garlic Powder |
| ½ C Onion, diced                               | Salt and Pepper     |
| 1 C Mushrooms, sliced                          |                     |
| 1 (8 oz) Can Tomato Sauce                      |                     |
| 1 (14 oz) Can Diced Tomatoes w/ Basil & Garlic |                     |
| 1 (12 oz) Package Angel Hair Pasta             |                     |
| ½ C Parmesan Cheese                            |                     |

Dice squash zucchini, and mushrooms into ¼ inch cubes. Finely chop onion. Heat oil, add mushrooms, squash, zucchini, and onion. Cook 5-10 minutes, stir in tomato sauce, diced tomatoes, basil, oregano, and garlic. Heat to boiling, reduce heat. Simmer covered 5 minutes. Meanwhile, cook pasta, drain. Stir ¼ cup parmesan cheese into vegetables. Toss veggies with pasta. Sprinkle with remaining parmesan. Salt and Pepper to taste.

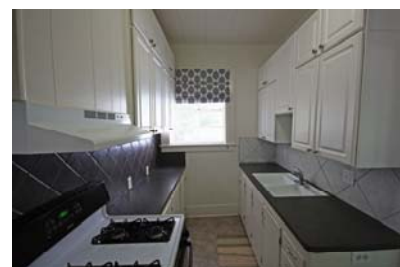
